

What is Diversity?




- Can refer to



Eradicate the Fear

- Reasons for fear
 - Cultural appropriation
 - Lack of personal experience
 - *Possible* reader reactions
- Eradicate the fear
 - Pray
 - Use sensitivity readers
 - Do your research
 - Focus on the characters



Cultural – Appropriation Avoid the Caricature

- Stereotypes can lead a writer to create a character that is more caricature than authentic
- The media shows the worst of us, so don't let that be your resource






- Backhanded compliments
 - "Pretty for a Black girl"
- Contrast teeth in relation to skin tone
- Avoid NAPPY and KINKY
- Avoid Black face, tribal features
- African American vs Black

Stereotypes to Avoid – Asians


- Avoid depicting shape of eyes as slanted or anything else derogatory
- Asian vs. Oriental
 - Items from Asia are oriental. People are Asian



Stereotypes to Avoid — Biracial and Multiracial

- Try to avoid stereotypes of their races
 - Ex: half-Black, avoid African American stereotypes

Stereotypes to Avoid — Latinos

- Avoid the "exotic" description
- Don't describe as brown
- Mexican ≠ Honduran ≠ Venezuelan
- Speech
 - Not all speak Spanish or have Spanish accent

Stereotypes to Avoid — First Nations & Indigenous

- Avoid drunken stereotypes
- Don't assume uneducated
- Avoid "Native American" or "American Indian" when possible and list specific tribe
- Don't assume all tribes do beadwork, powwows
 - Research, research!
- Don't assume pitying nature
 - Celebrate their culture





- Average looks


Diversity

 - They're what make a person not their skin color






















